

Cyprus Senior & Super Senior Amateur Ladies Opens 2024

Eléa GC, Paphos, Cyprus 21 – 22 September 2024

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY

Amateur ladies players who on 21 September 2024 have reached the age of 50 years old, conform to the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A, and hold a current and valid WHS HI within the limits specified in paragraph 4 are eligible for entry in the **Cyprus Senior Amateur Ladies Open**. Senior Players who were born either on or before 1 January 1959 are eligible for **either** the **Cyprus Senior Amateur Ladies Open**, **OR** the **Cyprus Super Senior Amateur Ladies Open**. At Registration, on Friday, 20 September, entrants (other than CGF Federated players) must provide proof of current handicap certified on or after 15 September 2024.

2. BUGGIES, CADDIES AND TROLLEYS

The Cyprus Senior Amateur Ladies Open is a walking competition, and no buggies or other form of player transport may be used. Cyprus Super Senior Amateur Ladies Open entrants are free to choose to walk or ride in a buggy by submitting the appropriate Entry Application Form. Buggies are limited and will be on a first-come-first-served basis. Players in buggies are not allowed caddies. Walking competitors are permitted electric or manual trolleys and caddies are allowed.

3. ENTRY APPLICATION AND FEES

- Applications for Entry must be made through the appropriate online Entry Application Form found on the CGF's website
 (https://www.cgf.org.cy/events/CSALO24) no later than Monday, 16 September 2024. Should the events be oversubscribed
 a Waitlist will be created with preference given to international players and those with low handicaps.
- Entry fee for those walking (Seniors or Super Seniors) is €145 (€95 for CGF Members and €40 for Eléa GC Members).
- Entry fee for those riding a buggy (Super Seniors ONLY) is €185 (€135 for CGF Members and €80 for Eléa GC Members).
- The fee for International players covers two competition rounds and one practice round without a buggy (two competition rounds only for CGF Members), competition days fruit and water, free range balls, and a prize presentation buffet.

4. FORM OF PLAY & HANDICAP LIMIT

Both tournaments are 36-hole stroke play events, handicap qualifying, using the Red tees, played in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R&A, the Cyprus Golf Federation, and any Local Rules endorsed by the Tournament Committee. In the event of a tie for the Seniors tournament, there will be a sudden death play-off. Other tied places will be determined on count back. The maximum exact WHS HI for entry is 30.0.

During play for both days, Live Scoring will be in operation, with scorers posted at predetermined places. Participants are required to cooperate with and assist the scorers in performing their duties.

5. Trophies

The winners of the tournaments will be the "Ladies CGF Seniors Champion" and the "Ladies CGF Super Seniors Champion" of the year. Net trophies will be available, while on Day 2 a Hole-in-One prize will be available on a par 3 hole (multiple winners share).

6. REGISTRATION

Registration opens between 0800 and 1330 at Eléa GC on Friday, 20 September, the official practice day. Any player unable to register by 1330 must call +357 96 533813 to confirm her participation.

7. PRACTICE

International Players wishing to book their free practice round on Thursday, 19 September or Friday, 20 September, should make direct contact with the club (email: $golfreservations@eleagolfclub.com \mid phone: +357\ 26\ 202001$). Additional practice rounds can be booked at a preferential rate of 650.

8. MEDICAL CARE

During play, a doctor will be on call at player's own expense.

9. CGF TERMS OF COMPETITION
