CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY

Amateur golfers of all nationalities, holding an Active Cyprus Golf Federation license and a Valid Handicap Index within the limits as stipulated below (paragraph #3).

- Additionally, competitors holding a Cypriot National ID or Cypriot Passport need to submit copies of their Cypriot National ID or Cypriot Passport to the CGF offices (cgf@cgf.org.cy) prior to the closing date for the event to be eligible for automatic inclusion to the National sub-divisions for Men, and Ladies.

2. ENTRY APPLICATION AND FEES

- Applications for Entry must be made through the online Entry Application Form found on the CGF's website (<https://www.cgf.org.cy/reg/CGFChamps25Entry>) no later than Tuesday, 1 July 2025. The closing date for Entry may be changed and a Waitlist created at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Should a Waitlist be created, and places become available, players will be balloted-in on a first come first served basis.
- Entry fee is €95 for CGF Members and €40 for Aphrodite Hills GC Members. (Refundable only in the event of cancellation before the closing date for entries).
- The fee covers two competition rounds, range balls, on-course fruit and water, trophies, and a prize presentation buffet. The prize presentation ceremony will commence shortly after the close of play.

3. FORM OF PLAY & HANDICAP LIMIT

The Championship is a 36-hole stroke play World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR) event, handicap qualifying, using the White tees for men and Blue tees for ladies. In the event of a tie for the Championship/s, there will be a sudden death play-off. For all other places as well as the National sub-divisions the results will be decided on countback. The Championship/s will be played in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R&A, the Cyprus Golf Federation, and any Local Rules endorsed by the Tournament Committee. The maximum exact WHS HI for entry is 18.0 for men and 24.0 for ladies.

4. TROPHIES

The winners of the tournament will be "Men's CGF Champion" and the "Ladies CGF Champion" of the year. The national players with the lowest gross score over 36 holes will be "Men's National CGF Champion" and the "Ladies National CGF Champion" of the year. There will also be Net trophies for Men and Ladies, while on Day 2 a Hole-in-One prize will be available on a par 3 hole (multiple winners share).

Please note that for any divisions/sub-divisions to run the minimum number of entrants in that division/sub-division is 10.

5. BUGGIES, CADDIES AND TROLLEYS

This is a **buggy only** competition and no other form of player transport may be used. Electric or manual trolleys may NOT be used, and caddies are NOT allowed. Spectators are not allowed on the course.

6. LIVE SCORING

During play for all competition days, Live Scoring will be in operation, with scorers posted at predetermined places. Participants are required to cooperate with and assist the scorers in performing their duties.

7. REGISTRATION

Entrants must contact the CGF not later than 15:00, Friday, 4 July (Tel: 96 533813, or e-mail cgf@cgf.org.cy) to confirm their intention to play.

8. PRACTICE

No practice round is included in the entry fee. Players wishing to play a practice round must make contact with the club directly (email: golfreservations@aphroditehills.com | phone: + 357 26 828 200) to make their own arrangements and payment.

9. MEDICAL CARE

During play, a doctor will be on call at player's own expense.
